

## DIRECTIONS TO PCC

**FROM THE SOUTH (Bedford & PA Turnpike)** Take I-99 North to PA 869 West through Osterburg, Wyant, and Pavia. At Pavia, follow the signs into Blue Knob State Park. Continue up the mountain to stop sign. Make a sharp RIGHT. Lane to camp is a few hundred feet on the right.

**FROM THE WEST (Johnstown & US 219)** Take PA 869 East to Pavia. At Pavia, follow the signs into Blue Knob State Park. Continue up the mountain to stop sign. Make a sharp RIGHT. Lane to camp is a few hundred feet on the right.

**FROM THE NORTHWEST (Ebensburg & US 22)** Take PA 164 East through Portage and to Blue Knob. Turn RIGHT at Blue Knob and continue to the Park. Just as you enter the Park you will come to a Y-intersection. Go LEFT and watch for lane a few hundred feet on the right.

**FROM THE NORTHEAST (Altoona & I-99)** Take PA 164 West to Blue Knob. Turn LEFT at Blue Knob and continue to the Park. Just as you enter the Park you will come to a Y-intersection. Go LEFT and watch for lane a few hundred feet on the right.

## GETTING READY FOR CAMP

### WHAT TO BRING

- ◇ Bible and notebook
- ◇ Flashlight
- ◇ Wash cloths and towels
- ◇ Soap, shampoo, tooth-paste, deodorant
- ◇ Clothes for a week
- ◇ Raincoat or umbrella
- ◇ Jacket and/or sweater
- ◇ Extra shoes
- ◇ Swimsuit
- ◇ Pillow
- ◇ Sheet for single mattress
- ◇ Sleeping bag or blankets
- ◇ Money for canteen (Suggested \$15 )
- ◇ Paper. envelopes, stamps
- ◇ A good attitude

### WHAT TO WEAR

Please select clothes for camp where Christian modesty is clearly portrayed. Hot pants, gym trunks, sheer or see-through clothing are not in harmony with the atmosphere at PCC. Shorts are permitted if they are no higher than four inches above the knee. The standard applies to both boys and girls. As for staff, we prefer they not wear shorts. One piece swimsuits for swimming are preferred. A cover-up must be worn going to and from the pool. Sweat suits are an excellent choice for sports. If the directors or counselors believe your attire is inappropriate, they will quietly ask you to change.

### DO NOT BRING

Alcohol, drugs, tobacco, fireworks, knives, or weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited at PCC.

The directors also request that electronic devices, such as iPods, DVD players, radios, etc., NOT be brought to camp. These items distract from the atmosphere of camp and interfere with participation in the program at camp.

Please do NOT bring unnecessary money and valuables .
