

DIRECTIONS TO PCC

FROM THE SOUTH (Bedford & PA Turnpike)

Take I-99 North to PA 869 West through Osterburg, Wyant, and Pavia. At Pavia, follow the signs into Blue Knob State Park. Continue up the mountain to stop sign. Make a sharp RIGHT. Lane to camp is a few hundred feet on the right.

FROM THE WEST (Johnstown & US 219)

Take PA 869 East to Pavia. At Pavia, follow the signs into Blue Knob State Park. Continue up the mountain to stop sign. Make a sharp RIGHT. Lane to camp is a few hundred feet on the right.

FROM THE NORTHWEST (Ebensburg & US

22) Take PA 164 East through Portage and to Blue Knob. Turn RIGHT at Blue Knob and continue to the Park. Just as you enter the Park you will come to a Y-intersection. Go LEFT and watch for lane a few hundred feet on the right.

FROM THE NORTHEAST (Altoona & I-99)

Take PA 164 West to Blue Knob. Turn LEFT at Blue Knob and continue to the Park. Just as you enter the Park you will come to a Y-intersection. Go LEFT and watch for lane a few hundred feet on the right.

GETTING READY FOR CAMP

WHAT TO BRING

- ◇ Bible and notebook

- ◇ Money for canteen (Suggested \$25.00)
- ◇ Paper, envelopes, stamps

WHAT TO WEAR

Select clothes for camp where Christian modesty is clearly portrayed. Sleeveless and/or low cut shirts, form fitting pants or any immodest clothing are not in harmony with the atmosphere at PCC and are prohibited. Shorts are permitted if the inseam is 8 inches or longer. For additional information please refer to the website.

If the directors or counselors consider your attire inappropriate, you will be required to change.

A cover-up must be worn going to and from the pool.

DO NOT BRING

Alcohol, drugs, tobacco, fireworks, knives, or weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited at PCC. In addition Phones, iPods, DVD players, radios, etc. are items that distract from the atmosphere of camp and interfere with participation in the program at camp.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF CAMP

PLEASE NOTE:

The PCC Board has established that the camper's family medical insurance will be primary coverage for illness or accident and camp insurance will be secondary.

A camper who wishes to attend a week other than his or her assigned week must obtain director approval in advance of registering for the week.
